The culture and history of Indigenous Australians will be honoured with a special flag raising and celebratory event on Tuesday 10 July.

The free family fun day will be held at the Camden Council administration building on Central Avenue Oran Park, as part of NAIDOC week.

Mayor Lara Symkowiak said everyone was invited to join in the celebration.
