## Dusk Log Book Run for learner drivers

Learner drivers can gain some valuable night time driving experience by joining in the Dusk Log Book Run to be held next month.

Camden and Campbelltown Councils have partnered to provide the free, after hours driving session to Macarthur learner drivers, who have already done the daytime Learner Log Book Run.

“The Log Book Run has been designed to expose learner drivers to new situations that will make them more capable and able to negotiate a range of traffic conditions,” said Mayor Lara Symkowiak.

“The night time route provides valuable driving experience that will build the confidence and safe driving practices of a learner driver,” Cr Symkowiak said.

The organised night time drive is held four times a year and is open to learner drivers with more than 25 hours of supervised driving experience.

The log book run provides:-

- A structured evening including orientation;
- Breath testing;
- License – registration and vehicle checks;
- Pit stops;
- Check points; and
- Covert and overt speed monitoring.

The Dusk Log Book Run begins at 6pm on Thursday 12 July 2018 in Campbelltown. Details are provided when participants book, which can be made by calling Council on 4654 7777.
