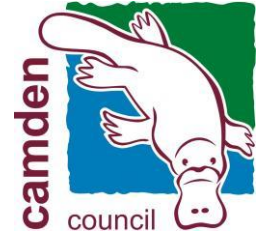

Get in the zone for an exciting world premiere

Camden Civic Centre is hosting the world premiere of a ground-breaking new production, which merges the worlds of dance and gaming technology.

Shaun Parker and Company will be performing *In the Zone* on Friday 13 September, 7pm, in the Civic Centre. The FREE performance is a first of its kind, showcasing the ground-breaking AirSticks technology that creates sound through movement. *In The Zone* promises to take the audience into a world of limitless imagination inspired by gaming and escapism.

Mayor of Camden, Cr Theresa Fedeli, said leading Sydney choreographer and company Artistic Director, Shaun Parker, developed the production in Camden.

“Shaun actually pieced the show together at Narellan Library and Narellan Community Centre, in front of an audience of local young people and dancers,” Cr Fedeli said.

“The audience then provided him with feedback, which he used to change his production.

“It’s incredibly special for Shaun to bring the finished result back to where it was created, and to show the young people who helped develop it.”

The audience will be treated to innovative sound design, which is the work of AirSticks creator, Alon Ilisar, and moves from young Western Sydney street and hip-hop dancer, Libby Montilla.
