Playing field at Narellan Sports Hub to receive an upgrade

The Narellan Jets Rugby League playing field, at Narellan Sports Hub, will receive a \$230,000 upgrade.

Camden Council appointed Renworx Pty Ltd to carry out the project at last night's Ordinary Meeting, which will include:

- Irrigation works;
- Subsoil drainage;
- · Maintenance of the existing turf cover, including rectification and levelling; and
- Upgrade of the existing floodlighting.

This project, which will occur during the rugby league off season, is scheduled to be complete in February 2020.

Mayor of Camden, Cr Theresa Fedeli, said the work was part of Stage Two of the Narellan Sports Hub project.

"There was an opportunity for the field upgrade to be completed as early works, before the official commencement of the main Stage Two works in mid-2020," Cr Fedeli said.

"I've seen just how much our community has enjoyed using the first stage of Narellan Sports Hub, which was opened in October 2017, so I can't wait to see the rest of this project pieced together.

"I'm excited at the thought of all sorts of competitive events being held locally, in our world-class, regional sports hub, instead of our residents having to travel far and wide."

The \$17.3 million second stage, which will create regional status for the state-of-the-art facility, will include the construction of:

- 14 additional netball courts;
- A full-sized rugby league field;
- A 1.5-kilometre criterion road cycling track;
- Extensive pedestrian and cycling paths;
- Floodlighting;
- Internal roadways;
- Additional parking; and

- A dedicated athletics facility, with:
 - An eight-lane, 400-metre synthetic track;
 - o 10-lane and 8-lane 100-metre sprint tracks;
 - Shotput circles;
 - High jump areas;
 - Javelin area;
 - A hammer/discus cage;
 - o Pole vault track; and
 - Double long jump/triple jump pits.
