Mayor of Camden, Cr Peter Sidgreaves said, with inflatables for all ages, it is the place to be during the upcoming school holidays.

“Whether you’re looking for an adrenaline rush while sliding down nine metres on the new Toxic Slide or you’re competing against a friend or sibling on the Aqua Rush Dry Obstacle Course – there’s an inflatable for everyone,” Cr Sidgreaves said.
